## BEFORE YOU START

We have an Art shop on site where we sell most of the required art kit at prices lower than most suppliers, however please ensure you have:

- A range of B pencils
- A small range of paintbrushes
- Eraser
- Sharper
- Scissors

Produce <u>6 lively pages</u> of exciting studies based on observations of your <u>own facial features</u>. My advice would be to not work too small and also to ensure that you fill your sketchbook pages with more than one drawing per page. Look carefully at the example image to see how other Art students have used mark making to effectively depict tonal values found in the human face and presented their studies in a lively manner.

You will need to work on A4 size sketchbook paper to present your transition work. Please do not use lined or printer paper. Do not spend too much money on a new sketchbook as you will need to purchase a square one from us in September for the official start of the project. You should only commit to filling one side of each page (that means do not work on both sides) so that any high-quality work can be easily cut out and placed into your new book in September.

We want to see the art that inspires you, please choose 2 artists to research. Present your findings across a minimum of 2 single pages for each artist you have chosen. Choose 2 different styled artists show us your breadth of inspiration. Your research pages should contain the following:

- High-quality examples of the artist's work (if you have access to a printer). Include notes on why you find the work interesting
- Practical studies/observations of your favourite piece/pieces of the artist's work.
