## **Apprenticeship Levels**



#### Level 2- Intermediate

Equivalent to five GCSE's Grade 4 and above. Completion time: 12- 18 months

#### Level 3- Advanced

Equivalent to A Levels

Completion time: 12-24 months

### Level 4 + - Higher and Degree

Level 4 & 5- Equivalent to Foundation Degree & HND Level 6 & 7- Equivalent to Degree and Masters Degree

Completion time: 12 - 72 Months

## **Wages Guide**

- £5.28 minimum per hour
- Many degree apprenticeships pay circa £25k
- Higher the level = higher the wages





## **Degree Apprenticeships**

Degree apprenticeships combine full-time work with part-time university, to work toward a bachelor's degree or master's degree across 3-6 years.

#### How you can benefit?

3-6 years of full time on the job work
experience in the sector you are studying
A fully funded degree with zero student loans
Create personal links and working relationships
with people in the sector prior to graduation
Gain knowledge and real life experience to
support alongside your studies
Grow skills (time management, communication,
confidence, organisation, IT...)



## How to apply & find degree apprenticeships

#### How?

You can apply for a degree apprenticeship in the same way you might apply for a job - by looking for opportunities and submitting an application.

#### When to apply?

Like any other job, employers can advertise a degree apprenticeship at any time, throughout the year.

There is no application cycle.

Apply through the Gov website or through the employer!
