

A level Summer Work 2019 Photography

You are expected to take 100 photos inspired by the theme of 'Shapes, Patterns & Textures'.

You will need to come to your lesson with the images on a SD card or a USB memory stick.

To complete the task you also need to print out your top 5 most successful shots.

If you have a camera you can of course use that but if you do not it is fine for you to use your phone for this summer shoot.

When you officially start the Photography course you will need to shoot with a DSLR. Melton Vale Sixth Form College provide a rental scheme.

A Few tips ...

- **Fill the frame with what you like** – what is your photo about? (get rid of everything else)
- **Think about angles** – take your time when composing your images
- **Think opposite** – can you make your photo different from everyone else's? What the most common place to take the shot? Do the opposite.
- **Lighting** – Photography literally means light painting – always think about the light
- **Framing** – put things in the frame to create a mood or a story
- **Subject matter** – show us that you have the initiative to take photos of lots of different things to respond to the theme.
