








Psychology Summer Work 2019

As part of the Eduqas Specification you will learn about **ways to investigate human behaviour**. When carrying out research psychologists have to use ethical committees and follow BPS (British Psychological Society) guidelines.

In the Component 2 exam you will need to be able to show knowledge, understanding and application of the following issues:

-  confidentiality
-  deception
-  risk of stress, anxiety, humiliation or pain
-  risk to the participants' values, beliefs, relationships, status or privacy
-  valid consent
-  working with vulnerable individuals (including children)
-  working with animals

For your summer work you must research each ethical issue above and create a **hand written** poster/report that includes:

1. Information about the ethical issue e.g. why it is an issue, or what would be considered unacceptable behaviour in psychological research (for that issue)?
2. How a psychologist should minimise the issue, either before or after the study has taken place.
