# **Ethos**

One of our greatest strengths is the positive ethos and culture that has been created at MV16 together with our outstanding facilities. Annual open events allow prospective students to visit and get first-hand experience of life at MV16.

# **Post-18 progression**

Whether you are opting to go to university or considering a Higher or Degree Apprenticeship, post 18 advice and guidance at MV16 is plentiful. Students benefit from extensive and experienced support with the UCAS process including preparation for Oxbridge, Russell Group universities and specialised courses such as Veterinary and Medicine. In addition access to master classes through our partnership universities is promoted along with residential masterclasses such as Villiers Park, Cambridge University and Oxford University. Furthermore opportunities to attend open days and higher education fairs are actively promoted.

# **Specialist** teachers, specialist curriculum

Joining MV16 means you will be studying at a college which puts learning first. Teachers at MV16 are skilful, passionate and engaging practitioners who specialise solely in post-16 teaching. We ensure they are up-to-date with subject knowledge and awarding body requirements that are essential in the current post-16 environment.

All students access five sessions of supported teaching per subject per week, along with supervised study periods and access to additional learning resources.

# Learning **Resource Centre**

Our Learning Resource Centre (LRC) is at the heart of the building. Its unique design allows students to develop and deepen their independent learning skills which will assist post-16 study, as well as providing the foundation for higher education. Students value the workspace and the working environment it promotes, likening it to a 'bridge between school and university'.

# **Opportunities**

Nothing is more important than enriching young people's lives and we pride ourselves at MV16 with the wide variety of opportunities we can offer our students. Our aim is to fully develop students' skills, values and interests beyond the classroom, so they develop as articulate and confident young people. We provide an extensive extra-curricular programme with high levels of engagement from the majority of our students.

# Support and guidance

Support for learning and success extends far beyond the classroom. At MV16 students benefit from their own personal tutor who will monitor their progress, achievement and approach to learning on a regular basis offering one-to-one support. In addition, students will have a close working relationship with our own personal careers adviser who offers high quality, impartial advice and guidance for higher level studies and/or their chosen career.

# Life after MV16

The majority of our students progress on to higher education or their chosen career through the increasingly popular higher and degree apprenticeship route. University is by far the most popular destination post-18 for students at MV16. The information and guidance received by students makes them very informed when it comes to choosing their course and university. This year, leavers have gone to all four corners of the UK. We are fortunate to have some excellent local universities that we partner with and many of our students choose to pursue their studies close to home, with a significant number attending the Universities of Leicester, Loughborough and Nottingham.

# Curriculum

MV16 offers a wide variety of A-Level courses, ranging from the traditional facilitating subjects to courses not normally available in secondary school. In addition, we offer a small number of BTEC courses. We have over 30 courses on offer and you have the flexibility to combine almost any subjects. Choosing subjects to study at post 16 is both exciting and demanding. We place great emphasis on pre-course guidance and the college is committed to ensuring that all students start on the course that is right for them.









### **Entry requirements**

To study A-Levels at MV16, you need to have achieved the general college requirements of a grade 4 or above in both GCSE Mathematics and English, plus three other GCSE or equivalent qualifications at grade 5 or above.

To study one of the A-Level sciences, you will need a minimum grade 6 in a related science subject.

To study A-Level Economics, you will need a minimum grade 6 in GCSE Mathematics.

To study A-Level Computer Science, you will need a miniumum grade 6 in GCSE Mathematics.

To study A-Level Mathematics, you will need a minimum grade 6 or above in GCSE Mathematics. To study Further Mathematics at A-Level, you will need a minimum grade 7.

To study A-Level English Literature, you will need a minimum grade 6 in GCSE English.

To study A-Level PE, you should be competing at club level or above for the coursework component.

To study A-Level French or Spanish, you will need a minimum grade 6 in the language you wish to study.

All other subjects require the general college entry requirements only.
